CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. The Background of the Problem

Speaking is an activity used by everyone to communicate with others. It takes place everywhere and has become part of people's daily activities. Many people learn English because they have moved into a target language community and they need to be able to operate it successfully within the community. A target language community is a place where English is the National language (Harmer, 2007: 11). On the other hand, students are included people who learn English as a second language used to speak and communicate to others. According to Bailey and Savage in Marianne celce-Murcia, speaking in a second or foreign language has often been viewed as the most demanding of the four skills (2001: 103). On the other hand, speaking is the most basic in English and it must be mastered by students in order to ease students to speak English.

Speaking is a crucial part of second language learning and teaching; it is because mastering speaking skill has goal that the students can improve their communicative skills, because, only in that way, students can express themselves and learn how to follow the social and cultural rules appropriate in each communicative circumstance. Remembering the importance of speaking in life, Wallace points out "to encourage students' ability in speaking, students must be able to know that speech should differ in formality, such as when



speaking to a judge, a teacher, a parent or a playmate." (Trudy Wallace et al.,

State Senior High School 01 Sentajo Raya is one of the Senior High Schools in Kuantan Singingi Regency. As one of the formal educational institutions, this school also conducts learning process of English language especially in term of speaking skill. Based on School-Based Curriculum (SBC), the second year and the third year students in this school study English subject two times in a week which has two hours per meeting, and the first year student in this school uses curriculum 2013. In School-Based Curriculum (SBC), students are required to learn and master four language skill such as listening, speaking, reading, and writing accurately in context of daily life uses, esspecially in speaking, students are not only required to understand the concept of a topic but also able to speak and express the meaning behind a text or speech used in daily life transaction. Based on the writer's preliminary observation in State Senior High School 01 Sentajo Raya Kuantan Singingi Regency clearly shows that some of the students still have difficulties and problems in learning English, especially in term of speaking skill. Students' speaking skill is still far from what is expected by the curriculum although they have learned English for about 9 years. But, most of the students still have difficulties in speaking and can not reach passing grade which is 78.

In the writer's preliminary interview, it is known that the teacher of English of State Senior High School 01 Sentajo Raya Kuantan Singingi

Regency used some techniques in teaching English. In teaching and learning process, teacher used monotonous strategy that caused the students unable to improve their speaking ability. Monotonous strategies that were used by the teacher are memorizing vocabularies, changing sentences, and holding English every Saturday

However, based on the facts that the writer found, the writer would like to offer a different technique of learning in order to improve the students' speaking ability in English at the second year of State Senior High School 01 Sentajo Raya Kuantan Singingi Regency. That technique is elicitation technique. According to Scrivener (2012: 98), eliciting means drawing out information, language, and ideas from the students rather than having the teacher gives them. The processes of implementing this technique according to Scrivener are as follows:

- 1. Teacher conveys a relevant learning topic to be presented to the students.
- 2. The teacher uses a picture to make the topic clearer
- 3. The teacher gives gestures to encourage students' feedback on the pictures presented
- 4. Teacher then asks a question to the students regarding the topic
- 5. Teacher gives turn to the other students to give different answer about the question
- 6. Teacher will compare the answers of the students and point out the mistakes or complete the missing information from the students' answers

The second year students of State Senior High School 01 Sentajo Raya Kuantan Singingi Regency are still encountering difficulties in learning English especially in terms of speaking skill. The followings are the indications found by the writer during his preliminary observation at the school:

- 1. Students are unable to speak based on the correct grammatical order.
- 2. Students are still lack of English vocabulary.
- 3. Some of the students are unable to comprehend the topic spoken about.
- 4. Some of the students are unable to express their idea fluently and confidently.
- 5. The students are unable to pronounce the English words correctly.
- 6. The students are unable to accomplish the objective of the elicited task.

Based on the facts depicted above, it can be stated that some of the second year students of State Senior High School 01 Sentajo Raya Kuantan Singingi Regency still face a big problem in terms of speaking. Therefore, the writer is interested in investigating the problems above into a research entitled: "The Effect of Using Elicitation Technique on Students' Speaking Ability at the Second Year of State Senior High School 01 Sentajo Raya Kuantan Singingi Regency."

B. The Definition of the Terms

The effect in Creswell (2008: 639) is a means for identifying the strength of the conclusions about group differences or about the relathionship among variables in a quantitative study. In adition, Richards and Schmidt (2002: 175) state that the effect is used to measure the strenght of one variable's effect on another or the relathionship between two or more variables. In this research, the effect means the result of using elicitation technique on students' speaking ability at State Senior High School 01

Elicitation is a technique by which the teacher gets the learners to give information rather than giving it to them. In the classroom, elicitation is an important technique for various reasons. It helps develop a learnercentered dynamic, it makes learning memorable as learners can link new and old information, and it can help produce a dynamic and stimulating environment (http://www.britishcouncil.com).

Speaking ability consists of two words, they are speaking and ability. To Islamic University of Sultan Syarif Kasim Riau avoid misunderstanding about the meaning of speaking ability, the writer clarifies one by one. According to Hornby (2000: 1289), speaking is to talk to somebody about something; to have a conversation with somebody. Ability is defined as the fact that somebody or something is able to do something; a level of skill or intelligence (Hornby, 2000: 2). It can be concluded that speaking ability is the ability of person to express his/her ideas, feeling, or something in his/her mind to others. However, in this
