Conclusion

Based on the result of data analysis, the researcher concluded:

- $\frac{60}{5}$ 1. The eighth grade students of Junior High School 1 Inuman Kuantan Singingi Regency taught by using schema activation strategy got better reading comprehension on descriptive text than those taught without using schema activation strategy.
 - 2. Using schema activation strategy gave significant difference on students' reading comprehension in descriptive text of the eighth grade at State Junior High School 1 Inuman Kuantan Singingi Regency.

It means that schema activation strategy has large effect on students' reading comprehension. The interpretation of the effect size of difference is considered Very Large.

Suggestion

Considering the effect of Schema Activation Strategy on Students' reading comprehension in Descriptive text, the researcher would like to give some suggestions for the English teachers and the students. Firstly, English teachers could use this strategy as one of the alternative strategies in teaching reading skill because this strategy can help the students to be familiar with the text they are going to read.
