CHAPTER V

CONCLUTION AND SUGGESTION

The purpose of this research is to know whether there is a significant correlation between students' perception and motivation in learning English. This research is correlation study. It has two variables that determine the process of doing the research .they are "x" as independent variable, it refers students' perceptions. "y" as dependent variable, it refers to students' motivation.

A. Conclusion

Based on the finding of this research in chapter IV, it can be concluded that:

- 1. Students' perception of classroom environment is categorized into middle level. It is based on the result of the questionnaires 62.5%
- 2. Students' motivation in learning English is categorized into middle level. It is based on the result of the questionnaires 56.25%
- 3. There is a significant correlation between students perception of classroom environment and motivation in learning English of the second year students at MA DarelHikmahPekanbaru. The higher students perceptions of classroom environment the better their motivation in learning English will be. It means the hypothesis (Ha) is accepted and the hypothesis (Ho) is rejected.

B. Suggestion

Based on the result of the research, it is clear that the good perceptions has important role to students' motivation in learning English. The author has some suggestion to improve the students motivation in learning English, they are:

- The classroom environment in MA Darel Hikmah is good. The teachers are expected to be able to establish a good cooperation in conducting development learning in the school. So the learning process will be optimal and the students will be motivated.
- 2. The teacher should give motivation and attention to encourage the students' interest in learning English
- Teacher has important role to motivate the students in learning process, which is expected to be more helpful in improving the students' motivation in learning English.
- 4. The students are expected to always create their own motivation as future expectation.

The writer realizes that this study cannot be separated from error either writing or research. So, the author expects some criticisms and constructive suggestion for the perfection of this thesis.
