1. The following statements need stronger evidence from existing literature:

"Many studies discuss how to streamline the relationship between business units through several strategies in supply chain management. A study examined performance measurement in supply chain channels to evaluate business processes (Simpson et al., 2002). Then, there is a study to improve the supply chain strategy by determining the optimization of existing channels (Yang et al., 2020). However, few studies were found to discuss the business unit's utility to determine the added value of products in the supply chain channel."

2. Consider replacing "supply chain chanel" for "supply chain" or "supply chain scope". It is not clear what is the difference.

3. Literature review should go deeper in the theme. I believe that the existant literature on the interplay

between supply chain management and business unitary management is wider. A systematic literature review is advised for sustaining your findings.

4. Exchange section name "material and method" for "research design"

5. A sub section in material and method/research design section about the objective of study (food supply chains) and the justification for your decision to investigate it are advised.

6. Discussion should go deeper in comparing the results with literature's existant theories.

7. Very interesting theme, good structure and well written paper, in my point of view.
